### **Outstanding Contributions May Include:**

1. Contribution in any highway related field, including the following: government, construction, design, materials, utilities, etc.
2. Using innovative design or construction techniques.
3. Use of innovative highway or bridge materials.
4. Contribution to community service.
5. Dedication to transportation industry (years of service).
6. Acknowledged eminence in the transportation field.
7. Responsible for major transportation improvement(s).
8. Original work, development, or activity.
9. Valuable contributions in improved practice and applications benefiting the profession, the community, and the transportation industry.
10. Contributions to increase knowledge and/or advancement of the profession (papers, other written research or practice).
11. Activity in local and national ASHE affairs.
12. Resourcefulness in planning, funding or implementation of projects.
